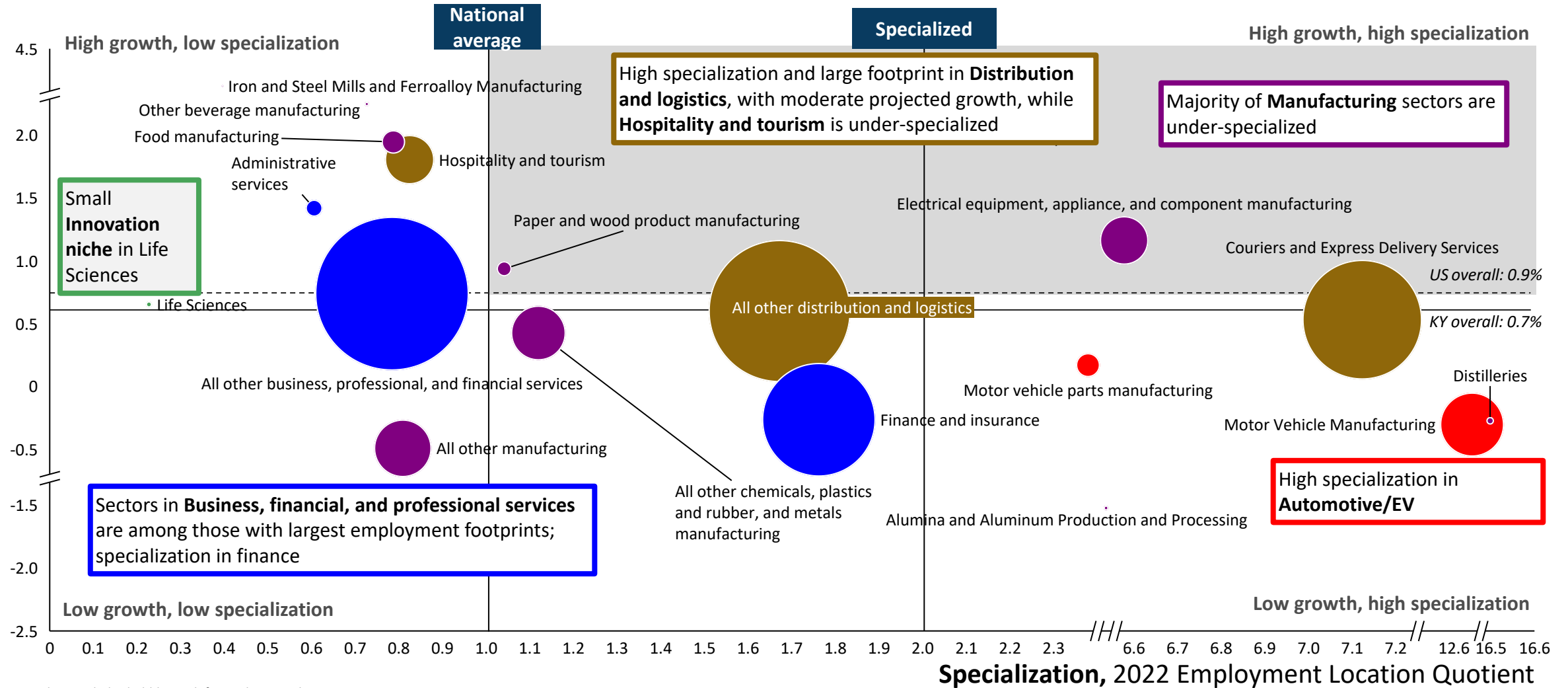

Employment growth, CAGR (2022-2032)

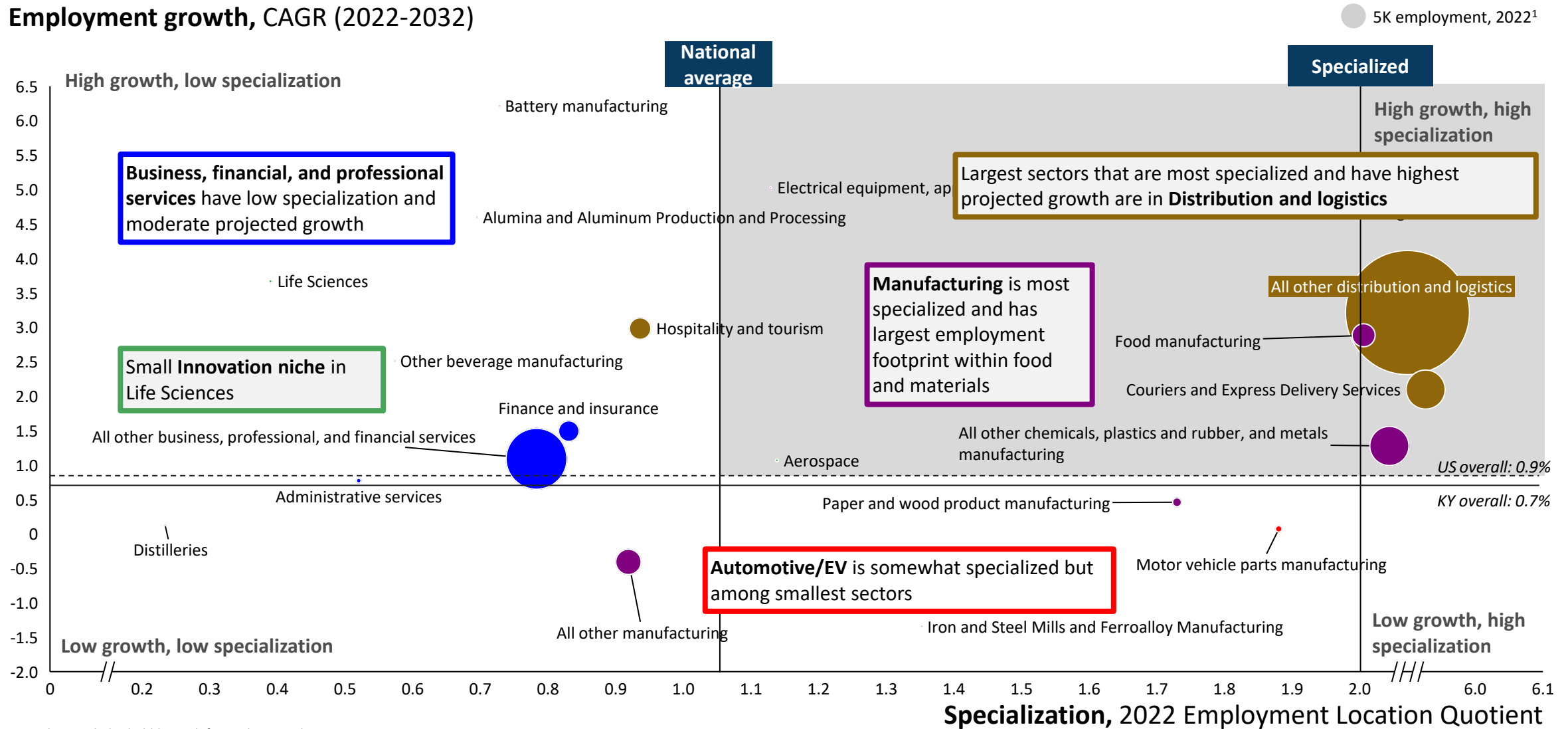

Employment growth, CAGR (2022-2032)

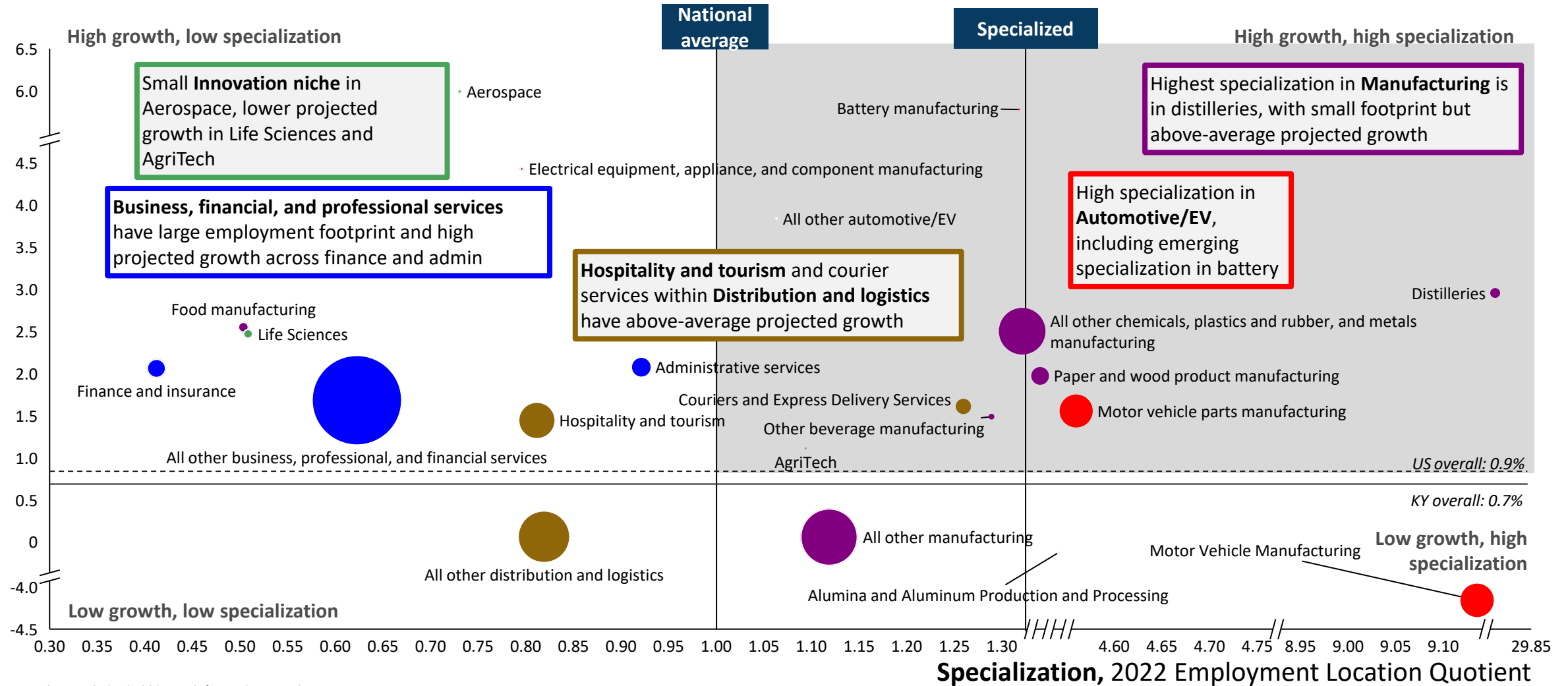
