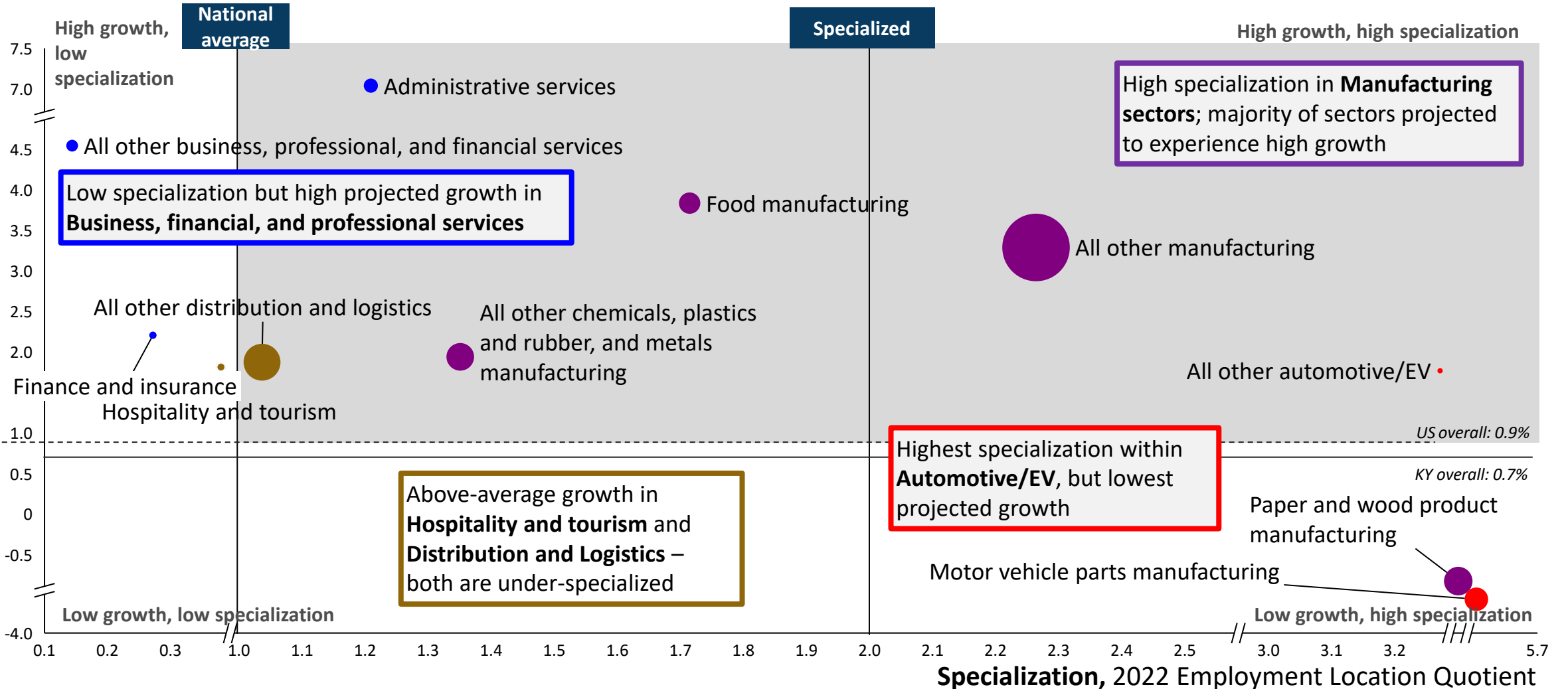

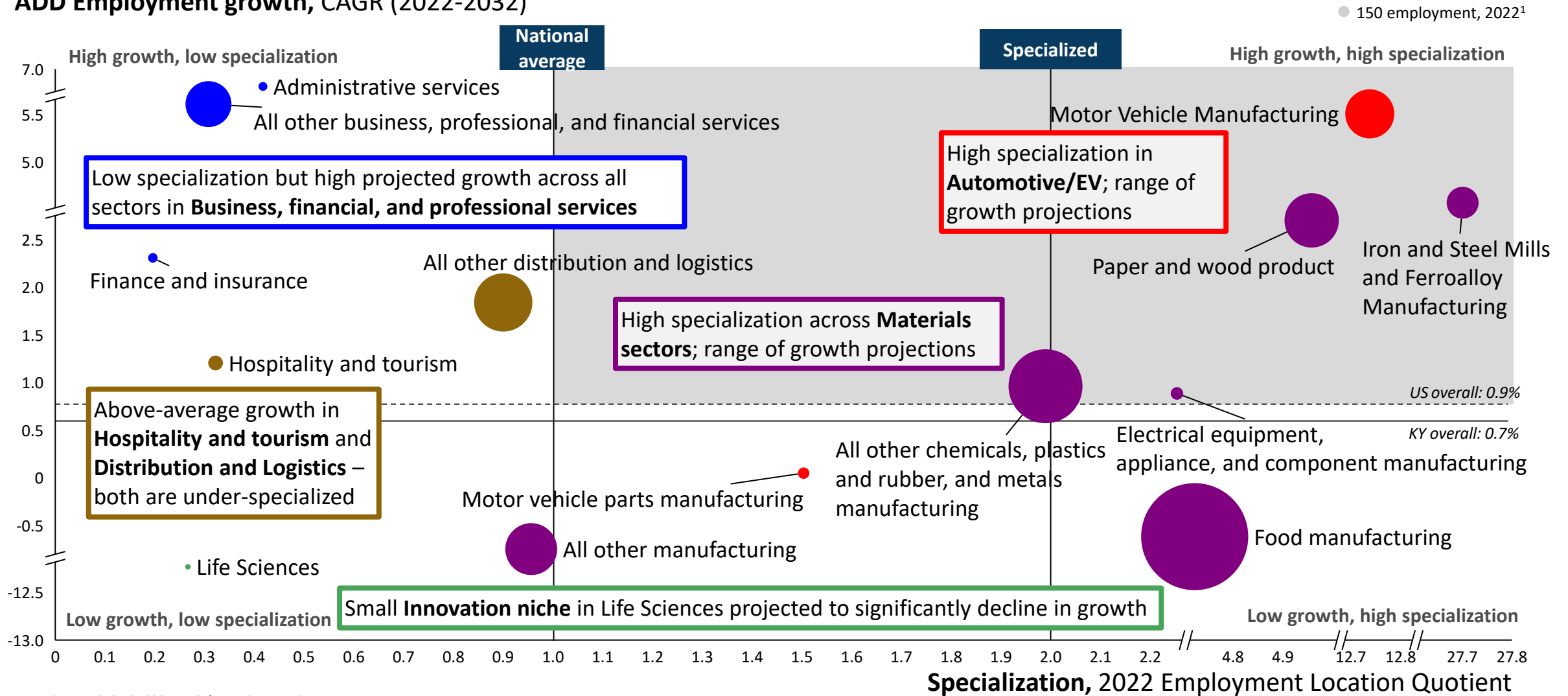

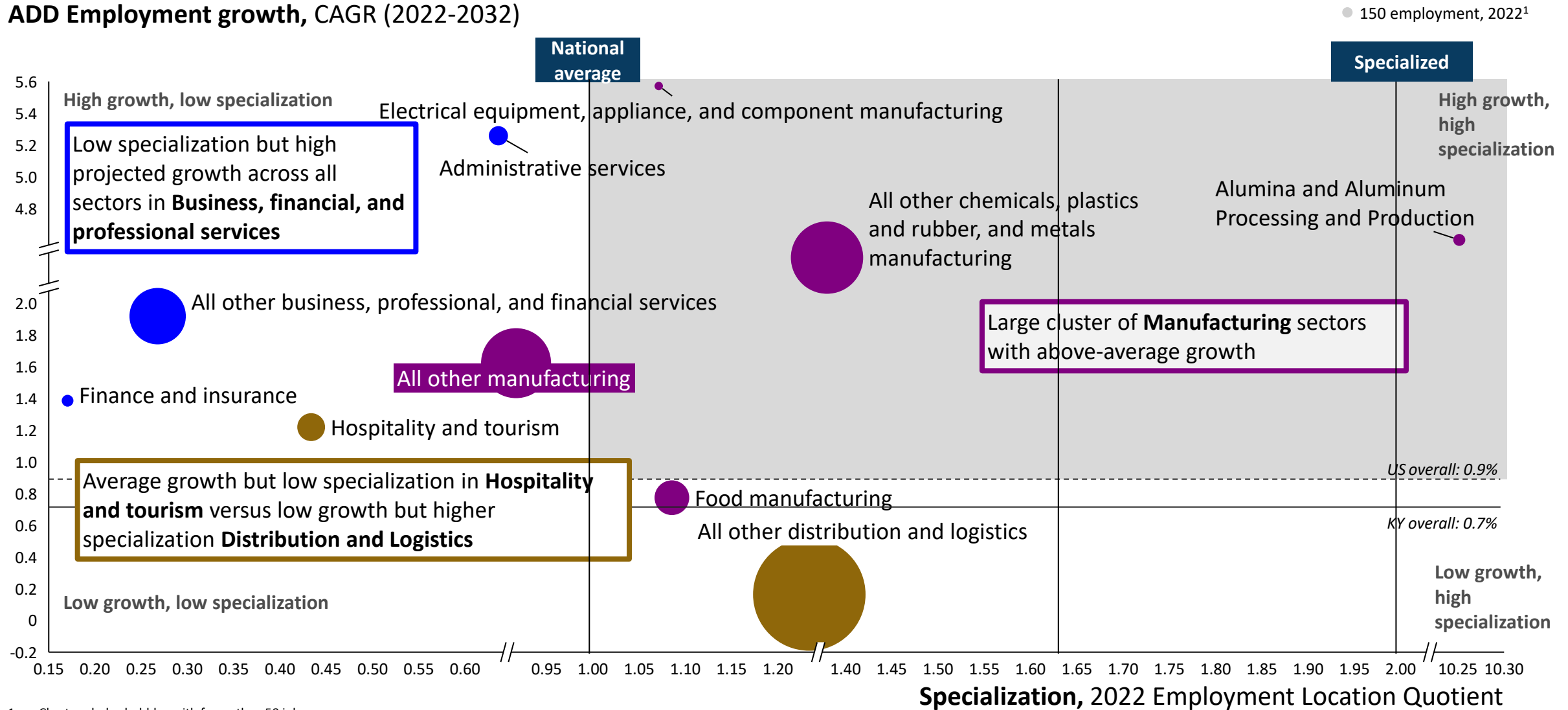
ADD Employment growth, CAGR (2022-2032)

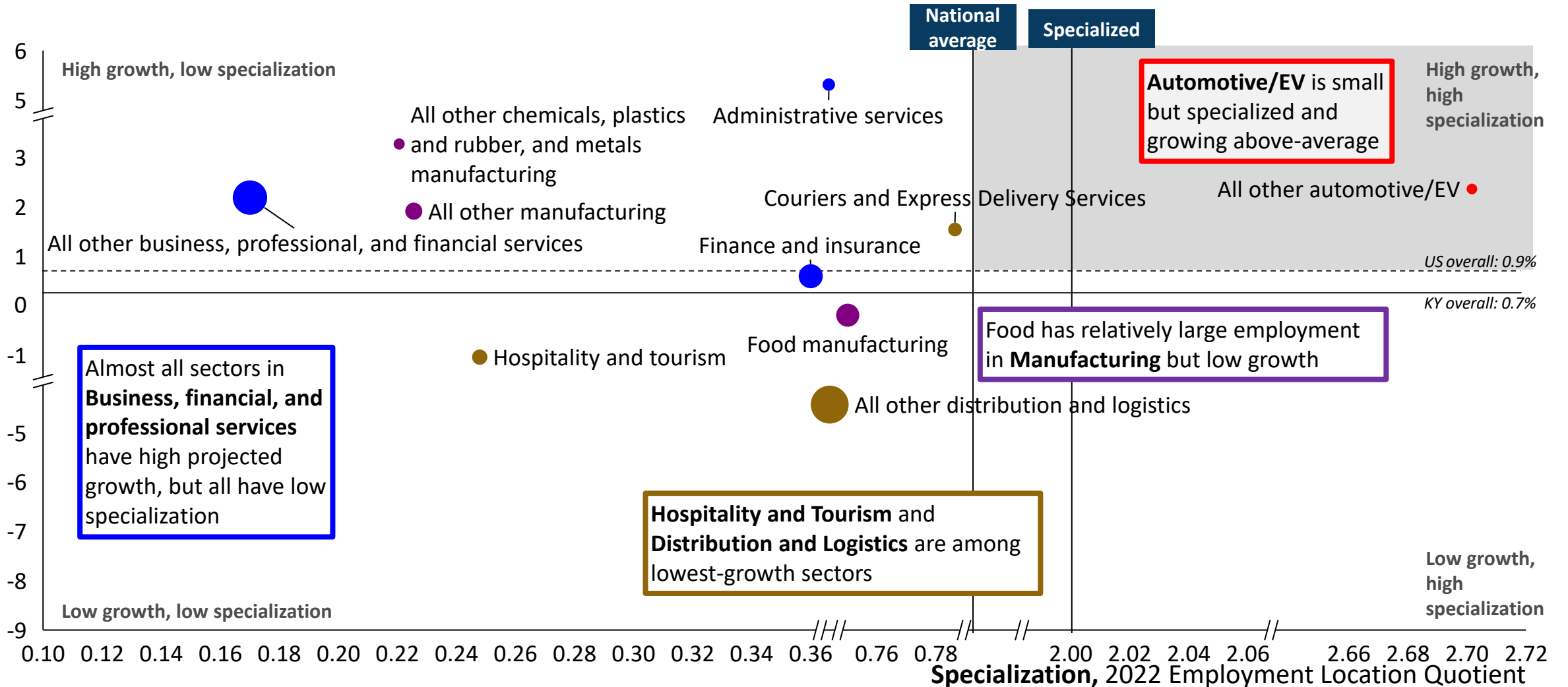

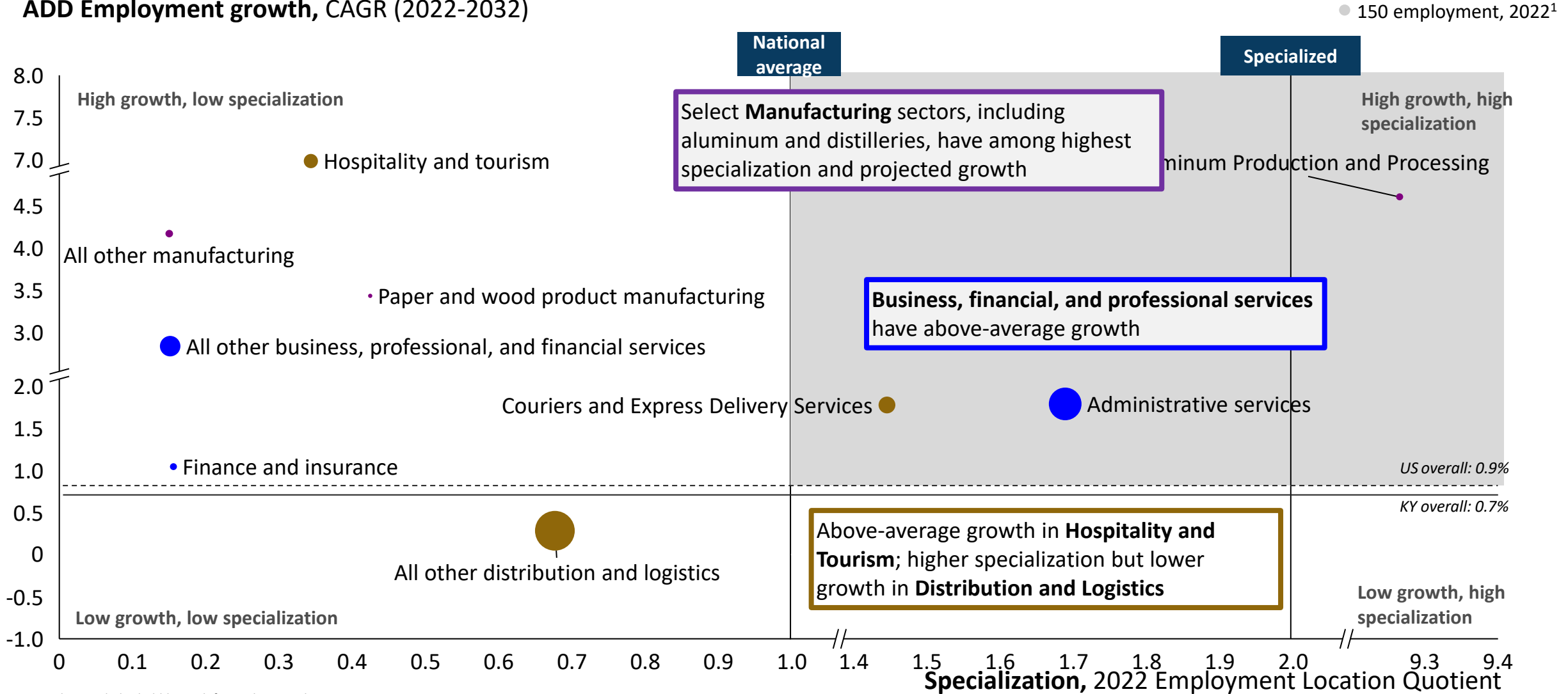

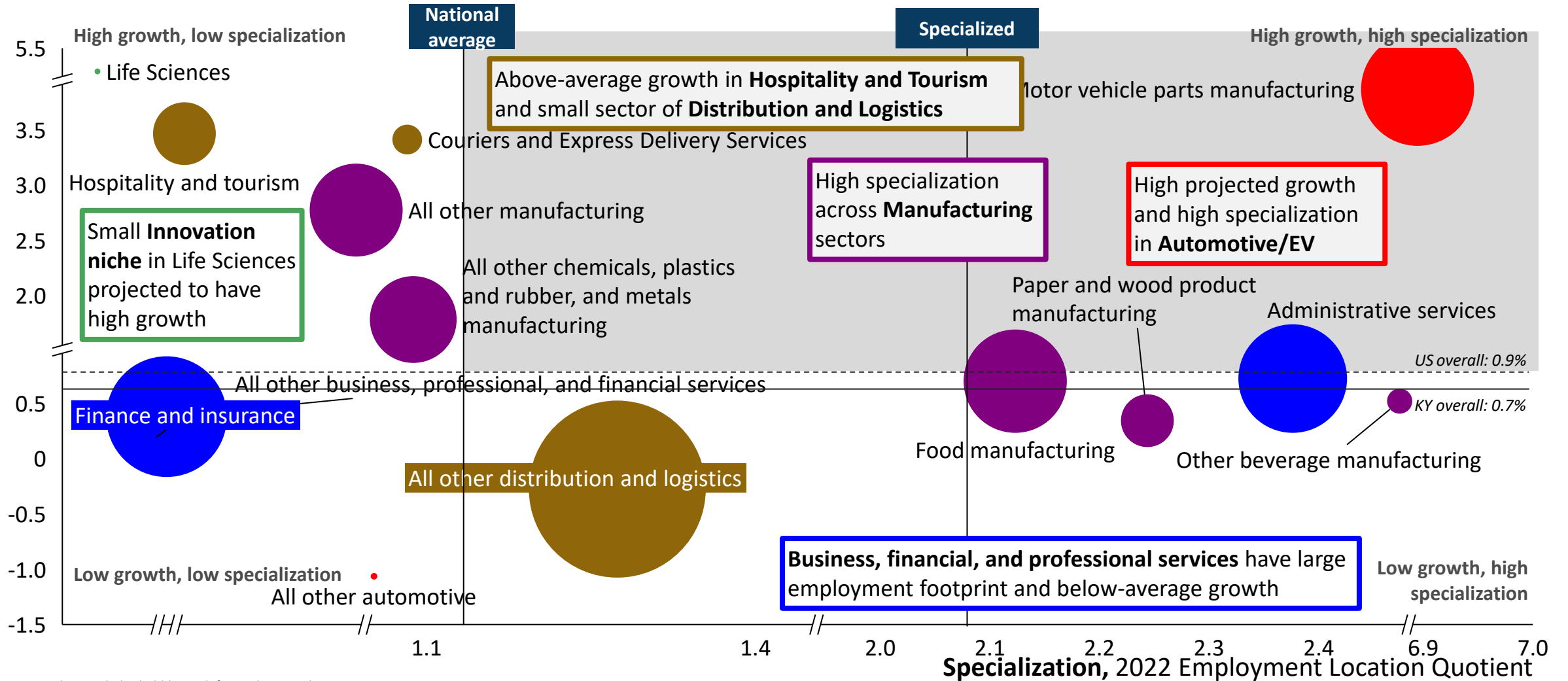
