



County Population Ranking and Required Local Match

KRS 154.14 requires the Cabinet to calculate the County Population Ranking on or before May 1, 2024 and no later than May 1 every two (2) years thereafter. The County Population Ranking is determined by adding the population density ranking to the ten (10) year percentage change in population ranking (both terms defined in statute). The dollar amount of the required local match is calculated as follows: The dollar amount of the required local match is the sum of the following calculation for each participating county:

$$\frac{\text{Requested GRANT Program Funding}}{\text{Number of Participating Counties}} \times \text{Local Required Match \%}$$

The table below details the required local match for each county according to the County Population Ranking:
