Louisville Renaissance Zone Pilot Program TIF (Jefferson County)

The Louisville Renaissance Zone Corporation (LRZC) was granted approval for a TIF project under the TIF Pilot Program statutes as they existed on December 8, 2003, and the Commonwealth entered into a Grant Agreement with LRZC. Under the TIF Pilot Program, projects in cities of the first class are eligible upon Governor's approval to receive taxes paid by taxpayers located within the tax increment financing district. For the Renaissance Zone TIF, withholding, sales and property taxes are eligible for recovery over 20 years if they were generated within the 3,000-acre TIF district (Development Area) south of the Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport, north of I-265 and bounded by I-65 to the east and CSX right-of-way to the west. The Grant Agreement, which includes Projects No. 1 and 2, expires December 31, 2023.

Background/History

The Commonwealth, Louisville Metro Government, Louisville Regional Airport Authority (LRAA) and others invested approximately \$800 million in the development of the Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) through the Louisville Airport Improvement Program (LAIP). The LAIP consisted of a new system of independent parallel runways, a new air traffic control tower, new navigational systems and other improvements serving as a catalyst for United Parcel Service's investment of billions of dollars in its UPS Worldport ® international sorting center located at SDF.

In connection with its Federal Aviation Administration Part 150 noise mitigation voluntary residential relocation program, the LRAA acquired approximately 700 acres south of SDF in the Minors Lane area at a cost of approximately \$155 million. This area is located within the Renaissance Zone Development Area.

The LRAA engaged in a master planning process to identify an initial group of public projects to acquire property, improve public infrastructure, and otherwise promote capital investment in and the redevelopment of the Renaissance Zone Development Area. The KEDFA Board has previously approved Project No. 1 and Project No. 2. The projects identified in Project No. 1 have been completed and have resulted in increased property values, dramatically increased employment and capital investment, additional tax revenues and general revitalization.


Project No. 2 consists of 17 approved projects and the total estimated construction costs at time of approval was \$30,321,000. Below is a breakdown of the original estimated project costs and the requested amended estimated costs.

The majority of the increase in the estimated project costs relate to the KY-841 Interchange Project. The Project No. 2 application originally approved included \$12,500,000 to fund 50% of the cost of road infrastructure, and the project is now requesting to fund 100% of the cost as previously anticipated federal funds were not obtained. The modeling and traffic analysis is complete, property has been acquired and final design, environmental review and applicable regulatory permits are underway.

The LRZC has been extremely successful in developing the Renaissance South Business Park with over 6.7 million square feet of industrial development that has supported approximately 3,000 jobs. The completion of the KY-841 Interchange, which is supported by business in the Renaissance South Business Park, will provide enhanced access to facilitate existing and future development.


Programs

The State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI) was created under the Small Business Jobs Act, which was signed into law in 2010. Pursuant to the SSBCI, Kentucky received an allocation from Treasury of approximately \$15,000,000.00 and KEDFA contributed an additional \$5,000,000 to fund the Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative programs. These programs included the Kentucky Capital Access Program, the Collateral Support Program, the Loan Participation Program and Kentucky Venture Capital Program.

On March 11, 2021, The American Rescue Plan Act was signed into law and provided an additional \$10 billion to fund the SSBCI to support small business credit support and investment programs. The SSBCI allocation from Treasury is over \$117,000,000 for funds to support significant opportunities for economic growth and job creation for socially and economically disadvantaged businesses in Kentucky.

In order to facilitate Kentucky's full utilization of allocated funds and to further enhance the KSBCI programs, the Cabinet requests authority from KEDFA to enter into the final application for the SSBCI funds due February 11, 2022.

Cabinet staff has prepared a proposed resolution to enter into the application for the KSBCI Programs and recommends approval from KEDFA.
