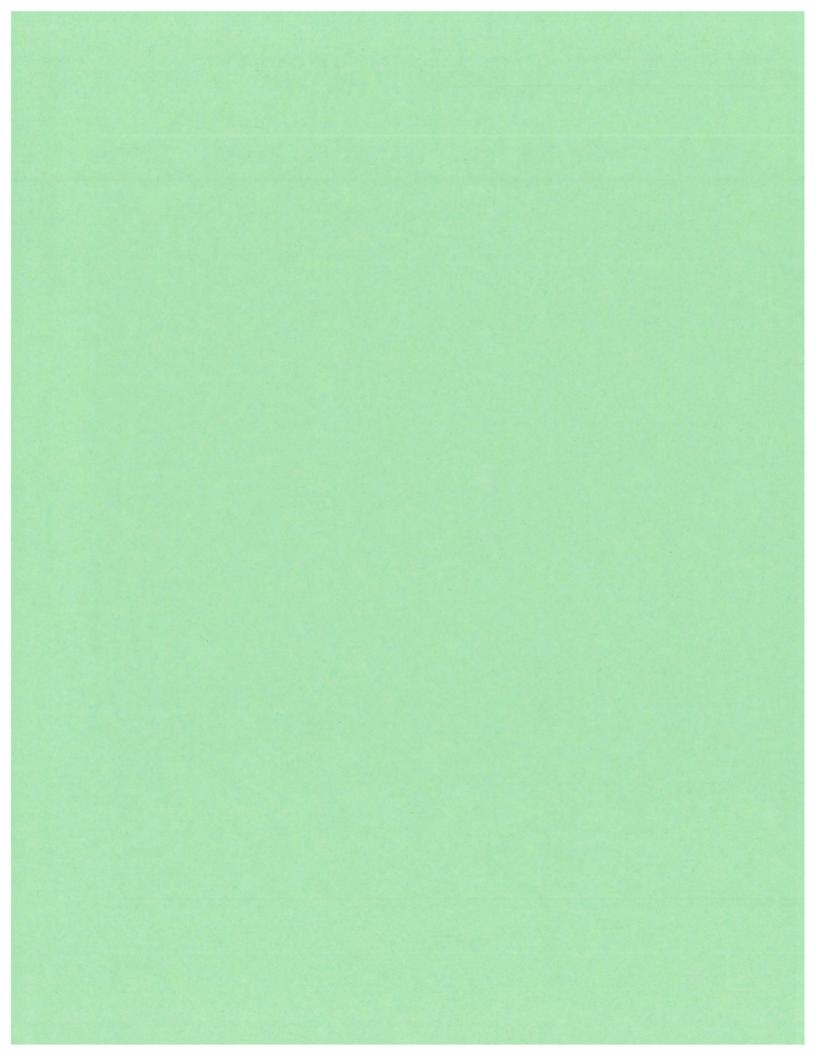
SUBJECT: KEDFA Board Meeting
