Pursuant to KRS 154.27-050(4), which pertains to projects approved under the Incentives for Energy-related Business Act (IEBA), the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA), jointly with the Department of Revenue, must prepare a report for the Legislative Research Commission on or before December 1 each year. The contents of this report are to include a list of all companies with which tax incentive agreements have been entered into and a summary of the terms of each agreement.

To date, KEDFA has entered into two tax incentive agreements that would provide inducements under this act. The report detailing the projects is enclosed.
