RE: Government Resources Accelerating Needed Transformation (GRANT) Program Annual Report for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2025

Dear Governor Beshear:

Pursuant to KRS 154.14-070, the Cabinet for Economic Development is required to submit an annual report to the Governor and the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue summarizing the monthly reports, applications received and relevant statistics for the Government Resources Accelerating Needed Transformation (GRANT) Program.

Enclosed is a cumulation of the GRANT Program monthly reports from June 1, 2025 (date program approved first applications) through fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, and includes the following data:

- Detailed report of applicants approved for obligated funds.
- Detailed report of applicants denied.
- Detailed report of recaptured applicants.
- Details report of disbursement of funds for approved projects.

The GRANT Program began accepting applications on May 15, 2024. Below is a summary of the statistics related to the GRANT Program through fiscal year ending June 30, 2025:

- 257 applications were approved.
- \$135.7 million of GRANT Program funds were obligated to match \$391.3 million of federal grant funds on total project costs of \$657.4 million.
 - 72 applications were from 501(c)(3) organizations and 185 from cities/counties.
- 83 applications were denied.
 - All denied applicants received detailed communication including any outstanding items and potential remedies to allow for future application submission.
 - Please note several of the applications denied have subsequently been approved in this fiscal year.
- 13 applications were approved but funding was not disbursed and funds were recaptured for future projects.
- \$6.6 million in GRANT funds were disbursed to 14 approved projects.

Additionally, KRS 154.14-070 requires the Cabinet to provide recommendations for legislation or policy actions needed to facilitate greater receipt of grant funding to eligible grant recipients. Below are potential legislative changes for consideration related to the GRANT Program:

- Organizations and communities participating in the GRANT Program have urged funding at the \$200 million level for the new budget.
- Allow for flexibility at the discretion of the Cabinet to extend out the approval of projects due to unforeseen delays to the federal award.
- Expand the qualified federal entities to include:
 - Department of Defense
 - Department of Justice
 - National Aeronautics & Space Administration (NASA)
- New Market Tax Credit and Revolving Loan Program – provide up to 10% of GRANT funds:
 - Target identified communities.
 - Create a revolving fund mechanism for assuring the compliance portion of the 37% federal income tax credit over 7 years.
- Develop a comprehensive/central system to capture activities/successes.
