Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation

Pursuant to KRS 154-12-277, the Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation (KY Innovation) within the Kentucky Cabinet for Economic Development (Cabinet) is responsible for various forms of entrepreneurship and innovation assistance, including but not limited to (a) providing customer service and project management with small and minority businesses (b) assisting export development (c) administering the innovation assistance set forth in KRS 154.12-278 (d) introducing entrepreneurs to individual investors and to investment capital firms interested in start-up and early-stage financing, and (e) collecting, summarizing, and disseminating information helpful to small businesses, including information on market research, federal, state, and local minority business programs, government procurement opportunities, and the availability of managerial assistance.

Overview

The Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation, a division of the Cabinet known to the public as KY Innovation, carries out the broad responsibilities of managing and administering the state's comprehensive initiatives for entrepreneurs, innovative ventures, and associated research. KY Innovation and the Cabinet focus on supporting Kentucky's future economy by building the pipeline of tech-enabled, high growth potential companies. The office also provides programs and direct services in support of the traditional businesses that make up the vast majority of Kentucky companies and employ more than 40% of our workforce. A diverse, vibrant innovation and entrepreneurship community is essential to adapting to a changing economy and driving advances in existing and emerging industries, as well as to supporting meaningful economic development within the Commonwealth.

Some highlights of this year's report include KY Innovation's programs assisting with the creation of more than 140 technology startups, helping companies raise more than \$167 million in private capital, and investing more than \$23 million, which resulted in more than \$59 million in private capital co-investment.

KY Innovation is proud to submit this report illustrating the continued impact of programs that support good ideas, fuel game-changing technologies and companies, and help Kentuckians become business owners who create well-paying jobs within their communities. The Cabinet and KY Innovation remain passionately committed to the success of entrepreneurship and small business growth in the Commonwealth. On behalf of our many partners and the businesses we all serve, KY Innovation expresses its gratitude to Governor Andy Beshear and the Kentucky Legislature for their continued support.

The following report summarizes the activities of KY Innovation from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.

Entrepreneurship and Startup Support

KY Innovation Hubs

KY Innovation's six regional Innovation Hubs are the hands-on catalysts for the expansive entrepreneurial and startup growth the Commonwealth seeks to cultivate. Each Hub, selected through a competitive RFP process, leverages local partnerships and works with other public and private stakeholders to assist entrepreneurs in many different industries and different stages of development. Partners include universities, successful entrepreneurs, angel investors and other venture capitalists, private sector companies, non-profits, local governments, and other economic development organizations with a role to play in fostering dynamic, resilient regional economies, job growth, and globally competitive communities.

The KY Innovation Hubs throughout the Commonwealth represent all 120 counties. During the reporting period, there were six (6) regional Hubs: Eastern Kentucky/ Appalachia (Pikeville), Greater Lexington, Greater Louisville, Northern Kentucky (Covington), Southwest Kentucky (Bowling Green), and Western Kentucky (Paducah).



KY Innovation Hubs are managed in partnership with the Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation (KSTC), a science and technology nonprofit with over 30 years of experience leading STEM programs. KSTC has long maintained partnerships through Kentucky, managed the KY Innovation Network for nearly twenty years, and is aligned with statutory requirements for providers of such services. With respect to the Hubs, KSTC currently handles various infrastructure, database, and support functions along with managing various events and marketing for Kentucky's entrepreneurial and commercialization efforts.



R&D and Commercialization


SBIR-STTR Research Commercialization Program

The Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) is the primary way in which the federal government funds commercialization efforts by small businesses and innovators across the country. The mission of the SBIR/STTR programs is to support scientific excellence and technological innovation through the investment of federal research funds in critical American priorities to build a strong national economy. Through a competitive awards-based program, SBIR and STTR grants enable small businesses to explore their technological potential and provide incentives to profit from its commercialization. Since 2006, Kentucky has supported various programs to support Kentuckians in applying for such funds, including the creation of an SBIR/STTR matching fund program that provides non-dilutive grant funding to awardees currently in or willing to relocate to Kentucky. KY Innovation also enables partner programs that provide early stage support to companies that are considering applying for SBIR/STTR funding, develop broad relationships with federal agencies, and seek out additional solutions to continuously support research commercialization. Through our partnership with the Kentucky Science and Engineering Foundation (KSEF), 1,203 client consultations occurred, including 45 new companies. These consultations assisted companies seeking federal SBIR/STTR funding. Along with these consultations, KSEF offered 16 Proposal Labs, with 76 companies participating, to assist with agency specific proposals across 7 federal agencies. KSEF also administered 6 microAward contracts to 10 applicants, committing \$30,000 in funds. The average microAward is \$5,000 to assist companies with expenses they incur submitting their federal application. In 2024, KY companies, receiving KSEF assistance, were awarded 22 Phase I awards, and 12 Phase II awards.

The Kentucky SBIR-STTR Matching Funds Program

This nationally recognized program, one of the most comprehensive of its kind in the nation, matches both Phase I and Phase II federal awards received by Kentucky's small, high-tech businesses or those willing to relocate to Kentucky. During the reporting period, the program matched Phase I federal awards up to \$100,000 to support exploration of the technical merit or feasibility of an idea or technology, and up to \$150,000 for Phase II federal awards, which support full-scale R&D.



Kentucky Commercialization Ventures (KCV) Program

KCV brings guidance, opportunities and programs to higher education institutions across the state without dedicated tech transfer resources, turning their research into products, services, startups and investments supported by intellectual property. Their work supported 17 disclosed ideas, protection of 4 intellectual property assets, and 157 opportunities shared with partners. KCV was involved in 11 proposals submitted,



with \$1.1 million in potential value to Kentucky innovators. Staff also provided 67 presentations and conducted 551 coaching sessions with faculty, staff and students at institutions across the state.

The Kentucky IP Alliance (KYIPA)

In 2022, KCV launched the Kentucky Intellectual Property Alliance (KYIPA) to advance knowledge of intellectual property protections in Kentucky. KYIPA worked collaboratively across KY Innovation and KSTC's innovation programs to educate more inventors and entrepreneurs about the importance of IP protections and the resources available.



Kentucky is looking at intellectual property protection through a modern economic development lens with KYIPA. During the reporting period, KYIPA grew its membership to 224 members, hosted multiple virtual and in-person events, created seven new free online resources and conducted more than 39 free consultations and educational meetings with clients.

Mid-South REACH (Research Evaluation and Commercialization Hub)

In September 2023, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) awarded Mid-South REACH (Research Evaluation and Commercialization Hub) to establish a new program across four states: Kentucky, Mississippi, Tennessee, and Virginia.

This unique partnership between Vanderbilt University, the University Louisville, George Mason University, and Jackson State University, brings discoveries and biomedical innovations to commercialization. The Hub supports Kentucky Commercialization Ventures, which represents all of the state's other public universities and community and technical colleges.



The purpose of the program is to accelerate the real-world impact of biomedical and health related innovations through education, mentorship, and financial support for aspiring entrepreneurs. During Cycles 1 and 2, REACH funded 12 KY projects (4 from UK, 4 from UofL, 1 from WKU, 1 from KSU and 2 from NKU) from 59 applications, totaling \$501,000 in awards. Since Cycle 1, Kentucky teams have already generated follow on funding totaling \$80,110 and have submitted one SBIR application.

Kentucky Established Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (KY EPSCoR)

The purpose of the federal EPSCoR program is to help states become competitive for federal research dollars by building research infrastructure, including support for faculty, students and facilities. KY Innovation provides the 20% federally-required state match for KY EPSCoR, which totaled \$1.1 million during FY25. Kentucky had active grants with both the National Science Foundation (NSF), NASA EPSCoR and U.S. Department of Entergy programs.

The R&D funded through EPSCoR has helped advance innovations at Kentucky's universities, while also training the next generation of innovators. Examples of successful programs in Kentucky include NASA EPSCoR, which provided seed funding that led to the development of Space Tango, and NSF EPSCoR, which provided seed funding for a multiscale nanomanufacturing node at UofL and UK, one of 16 nationally recognized nodes that help industry. Since inception, the Kentucky EPSCoR program has attracted more than \$480 million in funding, resulted in the creation of more than 1,650 jobs, and supported the creation of 31 companies formed utilizing EPSCoR-generated knowledge.

Funding and High-Tech Business Development

Kentucky Enterprise Fund (KEF) Program



The Kentucky Enterprise Fund (KEF) Program - managed by Keyhorse Capital, the investment arm of KSTC - invests in and provides other resources to seed and early-stage companies to build strong technology-based companies in Kentucky. KEF invests primarily in companies developing products and/or services targeting the life sciences, IT/Software, materials and manufacturing, environment and energy markets, and other early-stage, high-growth and scalable businesses. The programs function in accordance with under the guidelines provided in the Kentucky Innovation Act. Those guidelines (K.R.S. §164.6021) are as follows:

- Grants of up to \$50,000 for companies exploring the feasibility of technology commercialization or projects related to feasibility studies, such as incubator and accelerator programs;
- Funding of up to \$250,000 for companies in the concept development phase of technology commercialization; and,
- Funding of up to \$500,000 for companies advancing and promoting the program goals.

Applicants to KEF undergo a thorough due diligence process that includes research and analysis of the applicant's management team, technology, product/service, target market, business model, financials, competitive advantages, and competitive barriers.

To date, counting investments and other grants made, KEF has made more than \$59 million in investments in 558 Kentucky companies that have attracted more than \$2.5 billion in follow-on capital and created jobs with an average annual salary of \$90,000.

Commonwealth Seed Capital, LLC (CSC) was established by the Kentucky EconomicDevelopment Partnership Board (EDPB) and as an independent, single member LLC thatmakes investments in early-stage Kentuckybusinesses and angel funds to facilitate thecommercialization of innovative ideas and technologies. Over the reporting period, CSCcontinued to foster Kentucky's brightest ideas while continuing to prioritize scalable innovation, high technology, and strong growth potential as a private entity owned by EDPB. All CSC results are for calendar year 2024.

Kentucky New Energy Ventures Fund

The Kentucky New Energy Ventures Fund (KNEV) was included in House Bill 1 of the Extraordinary Session of the 2007 Kentucky General Assembly for the purpose of enabling Kentucky-based companies to undertake research, development, and commercialization in the field of alternative fuels and renewable energy. The \$5 million KNEV fund, since 2008, has funded 23 grants and 8 investments awarded to companies for a total of \$3.2 million in funding. No awards were issued during the reporting period.

High-Tech Pools Program

The High-Tech Pools Program (HTP), administered by KY Innovation, has used funds since January 2003 to assist companies and projects throughout the Commonwealth that work to support technology-based companies. All funding must be approved by the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA). No awards were issued during the reporting period.

Kentucky Angel Investment Act

The Kentucky Angel Investment Tax Credit (KAITC) program began in January 2015. Subject to a statutory limit of \$3,000,000 per calendar year, the program provides up to \$200,000 in non-refundable income tax credits to qualified individual investors. The purpose of this program is to encourage investments in Kentucky small businesses engaged in knowledge-based activities, create additional jobs, and promote the development of new products and technologies. Qualified investments may be eligible for up to 40 percent of the investment, as a tax credit, in enhanced counties, and 25 percent in all other counties.

From July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, a total of \$2,369,479 in Angel Investment Tax Credits were approved.

Small Business Incentives and Development

KY Small Business Tax Credit (KSBTC) Program

The Kentucky Small Business Tax Credit (KSBTC) program allows eligible small businesses paying taxes imposed by KRS 141.020 (income tax on individuals), KRS 141.040 (corporation income tax), or KRS 141.0401 (limited liability entity tax) to apply for a Kentucky state income tax credit. Subject to a statutory limit of \$3,000,000 per state fiscal year, this program provides a non-refundable state income tax credit for small businesses that create and fill one or more eligible positions and invest \$5,000 or more in qualifying equipment or technology.

Since 2011, the KSBTC program has authorized \$16,365,114 of tax incentives for 1,706 recipients, with 4,843 estimated new jobs. During the reporting period, \$1,548,00 of tax incentives for 161 recipients, with 453 new jobs, were authorized.

Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative (KSBCI)

Through the Small Business Jobs Act of 2010, the Cabinet applied for and received approval for \$15.5 million to create the Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative (KSBCI 1.0). In April of 2017, KEDFA authorized an additional \$5 million of bond funds from the KEDFA loan pool to fund projects through the KSBCI program. The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 reauthorized the State Small Business Credit Initiative, providing \$10 billion to implement the second round of this program. Kentucky's allotment for this second round of funding, which is being deployed through the KSBCI 2.0 programs, was approved by the U.S. Department of Treasury in February 2023.

Of Kentucky's \$117 million allotment for KSBCI 2.0, 30% is allocated toward loan support through KSBCI Participating Lenders and 70% is allocated toward venture capital equity investments in high growth companies. The KSBCI 2.0 venture capital funds are managed by Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation's seed-stage venture capital firm, Keyhorse Capital.

Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative 2.0 (KSBCI 2.0)

KSBCI 2.0 Lending Programs

KSBCI 2.0 includes two credit enhancement programs, the Kentucky Collateral Support Program and Kentucky Loan Participation Program. Collateral support provides cash collateral to an enrolled lender of up to 20% of their loan in order to enhance the collateral coverage of a small business borrower that is otherwise qualified but unable to meet the lender's security requirements. Loan participation allows the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA) to purchase up to 20% of a small business loan to support a participating lender to originate much larger loans that, on its own, would not have been possible.

KSBCI 2.0 promotes entrepreneurship, job creation and equitable access to capital. To increase equitable access to capital, KSBCI 2.0 offers enhanced collateral support of up to 50% on projects where the borrowers identify as Socially or Economically Disadvantaged Individuals (SEDI), Very Small Businesses (VSB), or Disaster Relief Affected Businesses (DRAB). KY Innovation has actively promoted KSBCI 2.0 to lenders with in-person presentations at the Kentucky Area Development District (ADD) offices and Chambers of Commerce across the Commonwealth. KSBCI 2.0 Lender Enrollment and Loan Enrollment is now available online. There are currently 58 KSBCI participating lenders across the state, including banks, CDFIs, and credit unions. 22 KSBCI 2.0 loans were approved within the FY25 reporting period.

KSBCI 2.0 Venture Capital Programs

Up to 70% of Kentucky's KSBCI 2.0 allotment is allocated toward creating early-stage venture capital programs. The Cabinet, which cannot take an equity stake in private companies, contracts with the Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation and its venture capital arm, Keyhorse Capital, to manage the equity investment process. The Kentucky Growth Capital Fund makes direct investments in early to growth stage, technology-based companies in Kentucky seeking private equity funding from angel and venture capital investors for working capital, growth, and expansion. In the last fiscal year, the fund made 39 investments in Kentucky startups totaling more than \$21 million. A minimum of a dollar-for-dollar private match is required. To date, the program has achieved a 2-1 leverage ratio, meaning that every federal dollar invested in a Kentucky startup, the company has also received two dollars in initial private investment.

KY APEX Accelerator

Formerly Kentucky Procurement Technical Assistance Center (KYPTAC)

The KY APEX Accelerator program, known until December 2022 as Kentucky Procurement Technical Assistance Center (KYP-TAC), promotes inclusive economic development by assisting companies with providing products and/or services to federal, state, and local governments. KY APEX Accelerator is funded in part by a cooperative agreement with the federal Department of Defense and is supported by KY Innovation via matching funds. KY APEX Accelerator's agreement with KY Innovation is managed by KSTC. In addition to helping small businesses prepare to compete for public contracts, KY APEX Accelerator professionals provide expert guidance on topics ranging from acquisition procedures and policies to cybersecurity. All services to Kentucky businesses are provided at no cost to the business owner. KY Innovation's matching funds are allocated to staffing for KY APEX Accelerator's statewide counseling services. Offices are currently located in Paducah, Bowling Green, Louisville, Lexington (headquarters), Elizabethtown, Covington, and Morehead. During the reporting period, KY APEX Accelerator served 882 new clients in 93 counties across Kentucky. Current KY APEX clients secured more than \$349,535 in federal contracts.

Kentucky Selling Farmer Tax Credit (KSFTC)

The Kentucky Selling Farmer Tax Credit (KSFTC) program encourages continued use of agricultural land for farming by grant ing tax credits to selling farmers who agree to sell agricultural land and assets to beginning farmers. The statutory program requirements are set forth in KRS 154.60-040. Sales involving immediate family members do not qualify for tax credit consid eration. The tax credits are non-refundable, but unused credits may be carried forward up to five years. During the reporting period, a total of \$40,310 in credits were approved.

State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) & Kentucky Export Initiative (KEI)

The State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) is made possible through the Kentucky Cabinet for Economic Development's partnership with the Small Business Administration (SBA) since 2011. The program, created through the Small Business Jobs Act of 2010, is currently awaiting full reauthorization by Congress. KY STEP is a reimbursement grant available to Kentucky's eligible small businesses to enter or expand into international markets. The Cabinet applies annually to receive an award from SBA and then accepts businesses into the program through an application process. Businesses then submit requests for reimbursements to the Cabinet for fees spent on allowable export development activities such as exhibiting at trade shows, foreign market sales visits, export training, trade missions, market research, and more. Agencies responsible for assisting the growth of Kentucky's exporters are collectively referred to as the Kentucky Export Initiative (KEI). Kyexports.com serves as a virtual hub of resources and opportunities provided by the KEI partners. Kentucky exported over \$47.9 billion of commodities in 2024 an increase of 19.07% over 2023.


Metals Innovation Initiative (MI2)

In FY 22, MI2 convened a founding set of eight Kentucky metals companies to explore open, collaborative, pre-competitive, de-risked innovation on behalf of the metals industry in the Commonwealth, a first-of-its-kind organization in the U.S. metals industry and in the state. Since that time, the organization has expanded to 13 metals industry members. MI2 has also focused on bringing the Kentucky metals industry more top-of-mind for key ecosystem partners in the Commonwealth.



MI2 was founded through the commitment of Kobe Aluminum Automotive Products, Logan Aluminum, North American Stainless, Novelis, Nucor, River Metals Recycling, Tri-Arrows Aluminum, and Wieland. Since its founding, MI2 has also added to its member organizations Ball Corporation, Bilstein Cold Rolled Steel, Blastics, Century Aluminum, Crown Cork & Seal, ElectraMet, Fritz-Winter, Hitachi Vantara, Kentucky Thermal Institute, Recycled Media, Recyera, Southern Coil Solutions, Toyota Tsusho, Trace Die Cast, and Transmission.

In the past fiscal year, MI2 continued to grow its membership and built initiatives around the focus areas of workforce training and development and sustainability. The organization co-hosted the first Kentucky Industry Conference, along with the Kentucky Association of Manufacturers and the Kentucky Manufacturing Extension Partnership, which brought together state, regional and national leaders to explore issues facing companies across all industries. MI2 receives funding on a reimbursement basis from the Cabinet through an agreement managed by Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation.




