Office of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Innovation

Pursuant to KRS 154. 12-277, the Office of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Innovation (KY Innovation) within the Kentucky Cabinet for Economic Development (Cabinet) is responsible for various forms of entrepreneurship and small business assistance, including but not limited to, (a) providing customer service and project management with small and minority businesses, (b) assisting export development, (c) administering the innovation assistance set forth in KRS 154.12-278 (d) introducing entrepreneurs to individual investors and to investment capital firms interested in start-up and early-stage financing, and (e) and collecting, summarizing, and disseminating information helpful to small businesses, including information on market research, federal, state, and local minority business programs, government procurement opportunities, and the availability of managerial assistance.



Overview

The Office of Entrepreneurship and Small Business Innovation carries out the broad responsibilities of managing and administering the state's comprehensive Initiatives for entrepreneurs and small businesses under the umbrella of "KY Innovation" within the Cabinet. KY Innovation and the Cabinet have focused on developing the pipeline of high-tech and research-backed companies within Kentucky that have the potential for significant growth and can complement our existing business strengths to maintain their success. Rapid advances in technology continue to accelerate transformations in traditional business sectors and create new ones. A vibrant innovation and entrepreneurship community is essential to adapting and driving advances in existing and emerging industries and supporting economic development generally within the Commonwealth.

In support of these efforts, over the previous two years, KY Innovation has refined the state's entrepreneurship programs to efficiently utilize our budgeted entrepreneurial resources and make targeted improvements in the services and opportunities for Kentucky's startup and small business community. We have incorporated a statewide collaborative approach to coordinating entrepreneurial support programs, developed stronger marketing platforms to ensure that entrepreneurs can quickly access the information they need, enhanced our financial investment systems and processes to efficiently link capital and spur investment within Kentucky, established clear accountability and transparency measures for ourselves and our private partners, worked to support the development of industry clusters, expanded our reach to target and support underserved and diverse populations, coordinated with the Commission on Small Business Innovation and Advocacy to develop a comprehensive resource of statewide programs that can support small businesses, and began developing talent attraction initiatives in conjunction with other partners to create a critical talent pipeline for our growing enterprises.

We created and continue to create new programs that fill critical needs and provide rapid growth opportunities. For example, in 2020 we launched Kentucky Commercialization Ventures (KCV), a partnership among the state's universities that supports the commercialization of intellectual capacity and develops talent across all public universities and institutions of higher learning. This effort further aligns Kentucky entrepreneurs with relevant university to turn our best ideas into great businesses. KCV has already won national recognition, including a coveted Federal SBA Award for its visionary work around building more inclusive R&D ecosystems. In early 2020, KY Innovation also relaunched the Kentucky Enterprise Fund (KEF) that invests in early-stage startup companies and the SBIR/STTR matching award program that matches federal grant dollars won by Kentucky's innovators, giving them key grant dollars to engage in high-risk but high-reward research and development work.

To date, KY Innovation's programs have helped over 3,000 small businesses and assisted those clients raise over \$1.5 Billion in funding. These companies have used our resources to generate over \$5.44 Billion in revenue and create over 12,000 jobs. Despite a challenging economic cycle due to the COVID-19 pandemic, according to the Kauffman Foundation, the startup early survival rate in the state of Kentucky in 2020 was 79.09%, higher than peer states with comparable populations such Oregon and Alabama and higher than neighboring states such as Indiana and Ohio. Continuing our support of these businesses is critical to our economic recovery – an economy that continues to win national recognition for the opportunities it creates for our citizens. KY Innovation remains passionately committed to the overall development and success of entrepreneurship and small business growth in the state and thanks the Governor and the Legislature for their continued support.

The following report summarizes the activities of KY Innovation from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.

Entrepreneurship and Startup Support

KY Innovation Hubs

For almost 20 years Kentucky operated a statewide network of offices to provide on-the-ground support for the entrepreneurial ecosystem through a network known as the "KY Innovation Network" or "KIN". When originally created, the Commonwealth's statewide program was novel and received multiple awards for its unique and impactful approach.

Nonetheless, following nearly two decades of this approach to assisting startups and small businesses, KY Innovation recognizes the need to build a more vigorous and adaptable 21st century entrepreneurial ecosystem. Current best-practices for state run entrepreneurial ecosystem support organizations involve deploying regional public-private collaborations that catalyze and support a significant increase in scalable startups throughout their life cycles, spur innovation, increase technology transfer and advancement of promising intellectual property, and ultimately benefit the overall economy through industry and job growth. Accordingly, in 2018, the KY Innovation Network program underwent a substantial revision to a series of six public-private partnership hubs with local independent entities servicing that region, now known as the "KY Innovation Hubs" or "Hubs".

Our regional clusters are the hands-on catalysts for the expansive growth the Commonwealth seeks to cultivate. Each KY Innovation Hub leverages local partnerships and works with other organizations, including universities, colleges, and economic development groups to assist entrepreneurs in many different industries and different stages of development. Included in the partnership are successful entrepreneurs, angels and venture capitalists, private sector companies, universities, non-profits, local governments, and other organizations with a role to play in fostering dynamic, resilient regional economies, job growth, and globally competitive communities. Entrepreneurial ecosystems that cluster and integrate regional assets and expertise within a larger statewide collaboration are proven to maximize each area's advantages and tailor programming to their regional needs, while also invigorating the state's overall entrepreneurial ecosystem.

There are six primary regional Kentucky Innovation Hubs throughout the Commonwealth: Central Kentucky (Bowling Green), Eastern Kentucky/Appalachia (Pikeville), Northern Kentucky (Covington), Western Kentucky (Paducah), Lexington, and Louisville. Regions with large geographic footprints have multiple offices and partners throughout the region. KY Innovation Hubs and their respective contractual partners strive to increase the likelihood that high-growth, knowledge-based businesses can be started in Kentucky and can obtain both public and private investments to develop and grow.

Our KY Innovation Hubs are managed in partnership with Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation (KSTC), a science and technology nonprofit with over 30 years of experience leading STEM programs. KSTC has long maintained partnerships with the Commonwealth, managed the KY Innovation Network for nearly twenty years, and is a statutory provider of such services under Kentucky law. With respect to the Hubs, KSTC currently handles various infrastructure, database, and support functions along with managing various events and marketing Kentucky's entrepreneurial and commercialization efforts.

From July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, a concerted effort has been made to identify KY Innovation's strategic plan in coordination with the Hubs and develop each regions priorities and align on a network-wide set of metrics to ensure accountability and track impact. Ultimately, KY Innovation seeks to ensure that whatever resources are available in Louisville or Pikeville are equally available in Paducah and Lexington, and everywhere in between. KY Innovation is particularly proud of the KY Innovation Hubs adaptability during this challenging year, as each of them pivoted where necessary to ensure small business and entrepreneurs throughout the state were served and had access to resources despite the challenges presented by COVID-19 pandemic.

Activity Highlights for Reporting Period



Sprocket, located in Paducah, launched a partnership with Codefi, to successfully implement the Code Labs program, which equips participants to become capable developers that can market themselves for coding jobs directly coming out of the program. The Code Labs program is free of charge for eligible participants and open to students without any programming experience. Sprocket is also in the process of constructing a new co-working space in Paducah. It also launched and funded the development of a new innovation center within downtown Paducah, and began a broader strategic partnership with Codefi funded by a grant from KY Innovation to expand entrepreneurial resources within the region.



Blue North, in partnership with INTERalliance of Greater Cincinnati, organized and executed a Startup Saturday event where high school students spent the weekend of November 20, 2020 tackling business problems for two local small businesses experiencing challenges due to COVID-19. Blue North has also worked to foster the development of a strategic industry cluster around logistics and supply chain enterprises, and hosted Supply Chain Meetups in Northern Kentucky in support of this effort.



Amplify Louisville, in partnership with Render Capital, sponsored the First Dollar Program. The First Dollar Program collaborates with four local organizations to provide \$5,000 dollar grants to underserved entrepreneurs who may not otherwise have access to early stage investment. Amplify Louisville also delivered several digital resources to the Louisville community, including a Startup Ecosystem Resource Map, a Louisville Startup Mentor board, and a statewide job board.



SOAR launched a Complete Guide to Entrepreneurship in East KY. The guide is available free of charge to the public and contains a wealth of information for entrepreneurs. In addition, SOAR took significant steps in corporate engagement through their work with a wide variety of companies, seeking to connect entrepreneurs to companies in need of their services throughout Eastern Kentucky.

CENTRAL REGION

The Central Region Innovation & Commercialization Center located in Bowling Green created the Virtual Management Organization program. The program is designed to help startups or existing, scalable, knowledge-based companies obtain immediate access to temporary c-suite executives in order to quickly obtain the requisite expertise to increase the probability and magnitude of their success in the region. CRICC is also in the process of constructing a Smart Space which will be an area designed for remote workers or individuals drawn to a coworking environment with both small private and open offices areas, adjacent training room, and nearby conference rooms.



In the Lexington region, Awesome Inc. facilitated seventeen company pitches to accredited investors and, its partner, Launch Blue had two cohorts of its pre-seed Launch Blue Accelerator program and three cohorts for the Launch Blue Incubator Program. Awesome Inc., in collaboration with its partner Base 110 served a total of 56 companies in their co-working spaces.

R&D and Commercialization

SBIR-STTR Research Commercialization Program


The Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) is the primary way in which the federal government funds commercialization efforts by small businesses and innovators across the country. The mission of the SBIR/STTR programs is to support scientific excellence and technological innovation through the investment of Federal research funds in critical American priorities to build a strong national economy. Through a competitive awards-based program, SBIR and STTR grants enable small businesses to explore their technological potential and provide the incentive to profit from its commercialization. Since 2006, Kentucky has supported various programs to support Kentuckians in applying for such funds. Currently, Kentucky supports a matching fund program that provides non-dilutive grant funding to award winners either in Kentucky or that agreed to relocate to Kentucky, provides early stage support to companies that are considering applying for SBIR/STTR funding, aids companies in developing broad relationships with various federal agencies, and helps companies identify innovative solutions to support research commercialization.

The Kentucky SBIR-STTR Matching Funds Program

This nationally recognized program, one of the most comprehensive of its kind in the nation, matches both Phase I and Phase II federal awards received by Kentucky's small, high-tech businesses or those willing to relocate to Kentucky. During the reporting period, the program matched Phase I federal awards up to \$150,000 to support exploration of the technical merit or feasibility of an idea or technology. Phase II federal awards, which support full-scale research and development, were matched by Kentucky up to \$500,000 for up to two years (following the contract year KY Innovation reduced the matching funds available to \$100,000 for Phase I and \$150,000 for Phase II, which aligns the amounts with our peer states and ensures that we can fund a wider range of recipients throughout the Commonwealth).

Since 2007, Kentucky has leveraged \$1.88 in federal awards for every \$1.00 awarded in state matching awards. The 42 companies that relocated to Kentucky have attracted federal funds from six federal agencies for a total of \$46.3 million – funding that would have gone to other states if not for Kentucky's program.



Improved Success in Obtaining Federal SBIR and STTR Awards

Since 2006, Kentucky has provided various forms of free assistance to companies and individuals in Kentucky to aid them in compiling the information necessary to apply for SBIR/STTR grants, and we have seen a corresponding increase in the number of companies that apply for and obtain these federal grants. In 2018, our early-stage assistance program was formalized through the Kentucky Innovation Investment Program (KIIP). This program leverages existing SBIR/STTR support and matching funds with a public-private partnership with a top industry consultant who has demonstrated an ability to further increase the number of SBIR/STTR awards in Kentucky. Looking forward to the next fiscal year, the Cabinet plans to increase the number of companies served through the KIIP program through proposal assistance and education outreach opportunities.

During the reporting period, through the KIIP Program, 41 companies were assisted in grant writing assistance and over 244 companies were assisted through educational, outreach, and training programs, all without expense to the company. During the same reporting period, the SBA SBIR/STTR program reported 25 Kentucky companies received 39 federal SBIR/STTR awards, totaling \$16.8 million. We have renewed our support of the KIIP program during the current fiscal year, and continue to believe such resources represent an extremely valuable tool for increasing Kentucky's startup success in high-growth industries.

SBIR/STTR Accelerator Programs

In addition to the general assistance provided through the KIIP program, KY Innovation launched additional support resources through targeted SBIR/STTR accelerators that helped prepare companies and inventors for applications to specific agencies. Because the Department of Defense is one of the largest funders, in March 2021 the Cabinet funded a partnership between KSTC and OK Catalyst to bring Kentucky's first Department of Defense (DOD) SBIR/STTR proposal accelerator. This was the first in a series of annual virtual DOD proposal accelerators to assist Kentucky companies navigating the unique requirements of the DOD SBIR/STTR program. The inaugural accelerator cohort saw 13 companies response to eight research topics. Twelve of the companies were first time applicants to DOD SBIR/STTR and most applicants were from an underrepresented group.

The Cabinet has also teamed up with LaunchBlue, a virtual accelerator program, to provide an SBIR One Day Lab program designed to help companies address the high-level commercialization strategies around their technology. As noted above, to ensure matching funding is available to support our higher number of applicants, the Cabinet has modified the amount of Matching Funds support for the upcoming fiscal year.

Kentucky Commercialization Ventures (KCV) Program

Kentucky Commercialization Ventures (KCV) was launched in 2020 through the Kentucky Science and Engineering Foundation, in partnership with KY Innovation, KSTC, the University of Kentucky and the University of Louisville, to develop the infrastructure and innovation culture that is fundamental to sustainable organic growth while also stimulating talent attraction in the innovation and start-up communities. KCV is a public-private partnership that unites Kentucky's public higher education institutions to advance innovation, intellectual property, and collaborative commercialization statewide through service to 22 regional universities and community and technical colleges across the Commonwealth. KCV is currently administered by KSTC.

In addition to the partners identified above, KCV's valued partner institutions also include:















The KCV partnership is driven by the vision that Kentucky ideas will change and improve lives. KCV works alongside its partners to expand access to dedicated intellectual property technology transfer resources and supports new venture to the benefit of regional universities and colleges that lack these resources and the entire Commonwealth generally. The initiative is nationally recognized as an innovative, shared service center model that sparks organic growth in Kentucky's technology sectors, contributes to an efficient product development infrastructure, and keeps Kentucky's best ideas protected to maximize their impact to Kentucky's growth. In its higher education community of over 165,000 faculty, staff, and students, KCV supports more Kentuckians to participate in innovation and startup creation than ever before.

2020 was a year marked with uncertainty as the COVID-19 pandemic began and caused all of Kentucky's public universities and colleges to move to a virtual environment. Despite this ongoing interruption and its sweeping impact on the economic health of Kentucky, KCV has persevered to support academic innovators virtually while prioritizing attraction of more innovation investment and notoriety to our state. In addition to several KCV innovator teams winning awards, the KCV initiative also won the 2021 Lab-to-Market Inclusive Innovation Ecosystem Award from the U.S. Small Business Association (SBA). KCV has also been featured by Translational Science 2021, the 2021 HHS Small Business Program Conference, VentureWell's OPEN 2021 conference, and the global 2021 AUTM Annual Conference among others.

Going forward, KCV recognizes the continued demand for a more connected network and culture of innovation throughout the Commonwealth. During 2021 Q1, KCV formed, in affiliation with the United States Intellectual Property Alliance, the Kentucky Intellectual Property Alliance (KYIPA). KYIPA is a multidisciplinary body of professionals, attorneys, educators, and inventors with a mission to promote IP education and attainment across the Commonwealth. In forming the KYIPA, Kentucky becomes the 5th intellectual property alliance in the nation. This accomplishment distinguishes Kentucky as a leader in intellectual property attainment and protection.





A significant amount of time is required to realize the results of Kentucky innovation ecosystem grant proposals, license deals, and other commercialization transactions in maturity. The commercialization transactions number will continuously increase over time.

Kentucky Network for Innovation and Commercialization (KYNETIC)

In 2019, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) selected five new hubs to be part of the national Research Evaluation and Commercialization Hub (REACH) network. The Kentucky Network for Innovation and Commercialization (KYNETIC) was chosen to receive one of these prestigious REACH awards. This is a unique partnership between the universities of Kentucky and Louisville, Kentucky Commercialization Ventures, which represents all of the state's other public universities and community and technical colleges, and the Cabinet.



The purpose of the program is to help identify and bring to market technologies that could benefit public health, as well as to establish a permanent culture for commercializing ideas and research emanating from Kentucky's higher education institutions. Projects are eligible for grants up to \$50,000 per six-month cycle and up to \$200,000 total throughout the life of the program. Each applicant must compete for funding against new applications during each subsequent cycle.

KYNETIC received 85 pre-applications during Cycle 2 and 73 pre-applications during Cycle 3 (coinciding with each reporting period). Six to seven projects were funded per cycle. A few of the developments related to those recipients of funding include the following:

- A UK team developing an Alzheimer's therapeutic formed a startup company and began participation in a prestigious accelerator program.
- An Eastern Kentucky University team developing a diagnostic and therapeutic filed for patent protection and formed a startup company.
- A UofL team developing a surgical device for wound closure has filed for patent protection and signed a non-disclosure agreement to work with a medical device company.
- A UK team developing a bone biopsy tool has filed for patent protection and since optioned their technology with a medical device company.
- A UK team developing a non-addictive pain treatment has signed a non-disclosure agreement with a pharmaceutical company.

Kentucky Established Program to Stimulate Competitive Research (KY EPSCoR)

The purpose of the federal EPSCoR program is to help states become competitive for federal research dollars by building research infrastructure, including faculty, students and facilities. KY Innovation provides the 20% required state match for KY EPSCoR, which currently totals \$1.2 million per year. Kentucky currently has active grants with both the National Science Foundation (NSF) and NASA EPSCoR programs.

KY EPSCoR is governed by a Statewide Steering Committee (Committee), as required by the federal program, which oversees budget and research decisions. Furthermore, the Committee ensures government, industry and university collaboration. Membership is comprised of university administrators, research faculty and private sector individuals.

KY EPSCoR researchers leveraged state matching funds to obtain over \$36.2 million in follow on funding. NASA grants have yielded over a 6:1 return on investment for state matching funds since 2018, which represents a 25% increase. To date, these projects have created 261 Kentucky jobs.

Funding and High-Tech Business Development

Kentucky Enterprise Fund Program

The Kentucky Enterprise Fund Program, managed by KSTC, invests in and provides other resources to seed and early stage companies to build strong technology-based companies in Kentucky.



A core part of the Kentucky Enterprise Fund Program is the Kentucky Enterprise Fund (KEF), which invests in seed and early-stage companies developing products and/or services targeting the life sciences, IT/Software, materials and manufacturing, and environment and energy markets, and other early-stage high growth and scalable businesses. The programs function in accordance to the guidelines provided in the Kentucky Innovation Act. Those guidelines are as follows:

- Grants of up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for companies exploring the feasibility of technology commercialization or projects related to feasibility studies, such as incubator and accelerator programs;
- Funding of up to two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for companies in the concept development phase of technology commercialization;
- Funding of up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for companies advancing and promoting the program goals;
- For new investments made on or after July 1, 2021, no qualified company can receive a total investment from the fund in excess of up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)

Applicants to KEF undergo a thorough due diligence process that includes research and analysis of the applicant's management team, technology, product/service, target market, business model, financials, competitive advantages, and competitive barriers.

During the reporting period, KEF made over \$4.2 million in awards to early-stage companies in Kentucky, awarding 31 companies with investment capital (from a pool of 52 applications requesting over \$12 million) and invested over \$3 million in 24 companies, bringing the KEF portfolio to 261 total investments in 153 companies that have generated over \$1.5 billion in private co-investments and private or public follow-on investments. To date, counting investments and other grants made, KEF has awarded over \$54 million to companies. As demonstrated by the below graphic, the number of potentially high-growth ventures seeking critical early stage funding continues to far outpace our funding budget for such programs.



Commonwealth Seed Capital (CSC)

Commonwealth Seed Capital, LLC (CSC) was established by the Kentucky Economic Development Partnership Board and is an independent non-profit entity that makes investments in early-stage Kentucky businesses, to facilitate the commercialization of innovative ideas and technologies. CSC invests in companies that have a significant Kentucky presence and the prospect for substantial growth. CSC also provides matching funds for other funds within Kentucky that support these ventures. All CSC results are for calendar year 2020.

Kentucky New Energy Ventures Fund

The Kentucky New Energy Ventures Fund (KNEV) was included in House Bill 1 of the Extraordinary Session of the 2007 Kentucky General Assembly for the purpose of enabling Kentucky-based companies to undertake research, development, and commercialization in the field of alternative fuels and renewable energy. The \$5 million KNEV fund, since 2008, has funded 23 grants and 8 investments awarded to companies for a total of \$3.2 million in funding. No awards were issued during the reporting period.

High-Tech Pool Program

The High-Tech Pool Program (HTP), administered by KY Innovation, has used funds since January 2003 to assist companies and projects throughout the Commonwealth that work to support technology-based companies. All funding must be approved by the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA). No awards were issued during the reporting period.

Kentucky Angel Investment Act

The Kentucky Angel Investment Tax Credit (KAITC) program began in January 2015. Subject to a statutory limit of \$3,000,000 per calendar year, the program provides up to \$200,000 per year in non-refundable income tax credits to qualified

individual investors. The purpose of this program is to encourage investments in Kentucky small businesses, create additional jobs, and promote the development of new products and technologies.

Qualified Small Businesses must be engaged in an eligible field, including: Bioscience; Environmental and energy technology; Health and human development; Information technology and communications; Materials science and advanced manufacturing; or Other new economy knowledge based activity.

Qualified individual investors making qualified investments in qualified small businesses may be eligible for a tax credit of up to 40 percent of their investment in counties with high unemployment rates, or enhanced counties, and 25 percent in all other counties.

Applications were not accepted during calendar year 2020 pursuant to statutory changes that temporarily suspended the program. Following the legislative re-enactment of the program, KY Innovation resumed processing KAITC applications for calendar year 2021. Through the end of the fiscal year on June 30, 2021, the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority approved a total of \$1,586,992 in potential Angel Investment Tax Credits.

Kentucky Small Business Tax Credit (KSBTC) Program

The Kentucky Small Business Tax Credit (KSBTC) program allows eligible small businesses paying taxes imposed by KRS 141.020 (income tax on individuals), KRS 141.040 (corporation income tax), or KRS 141.0401 (limited liability entity tax) to apply for a Kentucky state income tax credit. Subject to a statutory limit of \$3,000,000 per state fiscal year, this program provides a non-refundable state income tax credit for small businesses that create and fill one or more eligible positions and invest \$5,000 or more in qualifying equipment or technology.

Applicants are eligible to receive a tax credit in an amount not to exceed the lesser of 1) \$3,500 per eligible position; or 2) the total dollar amount invested in qualifying equipment or technology. Applicants are also subject to a \$25,000 maximum tax credit cap per applicant for each calendar year. Since the KSBTC program's inception in 2011, at total \$10,494,514 of tax credits were authorized. The 739 companies awarded credits created an estimated 3,126 new jobs. During the reporting period, \$1,332,000 of tax credits were authorized. The 124 awarded companies created 389 new jobs.

Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative (KSBCI)

Through the Small Business Jobs Act of 2010, the Cabinet applied for and received approval for \$15.5 million to create the Kentucky Small Business Credit Initiative (KSBCI). In April of 2017, KEDFA authorized an additional \$5 million of bond funds from the KEDFA loan pool to fund projects through the KSBCI program. KSBCI includes three distinct credit enhancement programs designed to generate jobs and increase the availability of credit to small businesses by reducing the risk participating lenders, credit unions, and community development financial institutions assume. KSBCI leverages funding from these private lenders to help finance creditworthy small businesses that would typically fall just outside a lender's normal underwriting standards.

The KSBCI program has provided over **\$21.3M** in total support to projects totaling **\$172.9M**

During the reporting period, KSBCI approved **\$340,000** of support to projects totaling over **\$1.7M**.

There are 53 KSBCI participating lenders across the state, including banks, CDFIs, and credit unions.

Kentucky Procurement Technical Assistance Center (KYPTAC)

Kentucky Procurement Technical Assistance Center (KYPTAC) promotes economic development by assisting companies with providing products and/or services to federal, state and local governments. KYPTAC is funded in part by the federal Defense Logistics Agency and supported by KY Innovation via matching funds. The cooperative KYPTAC agreement is managed by KSTC.

In addition to helping small businesses prepare to compete for public contracts, KYPTAC professionals provide expert guidance on topics ranging from acquisition procedures and policies to cybersecurity. All services to Kentucky businesses are free of charge.

KY Innovation's matching funds are allocated to staffing for KYPTAC's statewide counseling services. During the previous fiscal year, the organization added champions in Paducah and Louisville, expanding its service area in important markets for small business growth.

Kentucky Selling Farmer Tax Credit (KSFTC)

The Kentucky Selling Farmer Tax Credit (KSFTC) program encourages continued use of agricultural land for farming by granting tax credits to selling farmers who agree to sell agricultural land and assets to beginning farmers. Farmers wanting to sell agricultural land and assets may be eligible for a Kentucky income tax credit up to 5% of the purchase price of qualifying agricultural assets, subject to a \$25,000 calendar year cap and a \$100,000 lifetime cap. The statutory program requirements are set forth in KRS 154.60-040. Sales involving immediate family members do not qualify for tax credit consideration.

Tax credits awarded through this program may be claimed against the Kentucky individual income tax imposed by KRS 141.020, the corporation income tax imposed by KRS 141.040, and the limited liability entity tax imposed by KRS 141.0401. The tax credits are non-refundable, but unused credits may be carried forward up to five years.

The total combined allocation of tax credits available for both the Kentucky Selling Farmer Tax Credit program and the Kentucky Small Business Tax Credit program is \$3,000,000 per fiscal year. Both programs draw from the same tax credit pool. During the reporting period, a total of \$108,032 in KSFTCs were approved.

International Business Development

State Trade Expansion Program (STEP) & Kentucky Export Initiative (KEI)

The Small Business Jobs Act of 2010 created STEP in partnership with U.S. states and territories to assist small businesses with entering and expanding into international markets. The Cabinet receives an annual or bi-annual competitive financial award from the Small Business Administration (SBA). The Cabinet then matches a percentage of funding. Eligible Kentucky small businesses are admitted into STEP through an application process and receive reimbursement awards for allowable activities. The Cabinet submits quarterly reports on disbursements and outcomes of grant activity to the SBA.

Following Kentucky's entry into the STEP program in 2011, the Cabinet created the Kentucky Export Initiative (KEI) to unite and streamline efforts of Kentucky's international trade partners. The initiative's focus is to assist Kentucky companies increase their revenue by finding new markets for their products, with the expectation that increased revenue will create new jobs, retain current employees, and boost GDP. The revamped KEI website launched in June 2021, and improves the user experience for Kentucky companies visiting the site. The STEP application, identification of resources, and other features on the site make it easy for businesses to find information on exporting and connect with KEI partners for export assistance.

Kentucky exported \$25 billion of its goods and services to 188 countries in 2020. The confluence of the COVID-19 pandemic and international tariffs on U.S. goods and services resulted in a 25% decrease from 2019. However, the exports of Kentucky's competitors also declined during this time. Kentucky is well positioned to reclaim the momentum and success that saw the Commonwealth increase its international exports for 11 consecutive years.

Kentucky companies continue to show strong interest in the STEP grant during the pandemic. For example, companies claimed reimbursements on activities such as participating in virtual and domestic trade shows, building e-commerce platforms, translating websites and manuals to foreign languages, designing marketing media, shipping product samples, and subscribing to U.S. Commercial Service resources such as the International Partner Search.

The SBA extended the grant periods for STEP Years 7 and 9 due to the pandemic. CED successfully closed STEP Year 7 six months ahead of the September 29, 2021 deadline. STEP Year 8 funds are on-track to be expended by the September 29, 2021 deadline. CED is currently accepting applications and approving reimbursements for STEP Year 9. The Year 9 grant ends on or before September 29, 2022 depending on the availability of funds.


Governor's School for Entrepreneurs (GSE)

The Governor's School for Entrepreneurs (GSE) is a three-week residential summer program where young entrepreneurs, working in teams, take an idea and utilize STEAM and enterprise skills to create a service or product. Because of strong partnerships with entities such as the Kentucky Education and Workforce Development Cabinet, the Cabinet, Toyota Motor Manufacturing Kentucky (TMMK), PNC and numerous public and private supporters like the Marksbury Family Foundation and Nate Morris of Rubicon Global, GSE is completely free for selected entrepreneurs.

GOVERNOR'S SCHOOL FOR ENTREPRENEURS

This past summer, GSE added a second session to give 120 Kentucky teens, up from 72 in previous years, an opportunity to explore their entrepreneurial spirits and pitch their business startup ideas at two highly competitive Demo Days on June 26 and July 24. More than 300 high school students applied to participate in the two residential 2021 GSE sessions that ran from June 6 - 26 and July 5 - 24 at Northern Kentucky University (NKU). Teams of students developed business models, designed prototypes and pitched their startup ideas at NKU to a prestigious panel of entrepreneur judges and an audience of 300 during each of the Demo Day events. Out of 15 innovative startup ideas for a service or product developed during each session, three teams of teen entrepreneurs earned cash prizes to continue their ventures. The 2021 Demo Day finalists were the following:

GSE Session 1 (June 6 - 26)





First Place – **BranchOut** received \$1,000 for the development of an app that connects high school students to educational and career opportunities in Kentucky.



First Place – **TEHRA** received \$1,000 for the development of an online marketplace that allows consumers to select from a variety of eco-friendly, sustainable home resources, from lumber to light bulbs.



Second Place – Fill It received \$750 for the creation of a refillable laundry detergent system to reduce plastic waste while letting families use their favorite laundry detergents.



Second Place – Nexcus Bond received \$750 for the creation of a durable and safe cover for chemotherapy ports, allowing patients to move with less fear of getting an infection or damaging their port.



Third Place – Secura received \$500 for the development of an app that connects women instantaneously based on location and need, allowing them to take self-defense classes together and access other opportunities and tools to defend themselves from an assault.



Third Place – **SwimSafe** received \$500 for the development of an educational water safety organization that caters specifically to autistic children and their affinity for water.

GSE is a relative newcomer on the list of Kentucky's Governor's Schools, having opened to its first group of students in 2013. Since 2013, more than 600 student entrepreneurs have gained vital entrepreneurial skills through the program to use as they enter the workplace or continue into higher education. GSE alumni have launched more than 20 new businesses, filed multiple patents and developed new ideas and relationships that sow the seeds for more business formation. Dozens of alumni have chosen to enroll in entrepreneurial programs at Kentucky universities and attribute this decision to the inspiration they received by attending GSE in high school. GSE fosters and empowers the Commonwealth's future business owners and community leaders, giving these teens the support they need to go from high school students to business owners.
